RE: Survey Meter Calibration

In the past, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency's Radiological Instrument Maintenance & Calibration (RIM&C) Laboratory calibrated radiation detection equipment for any organization or individual. In recent internal meetings, Ohio EMA reviewed the role of the RIM&C, including the customer base it was meant to support, and concluded that the core function of the RIM&C is to support government entities, political subdivisions, local school districts, and state institutions of higher education. In order to more effectively support this core function, effective immediately, the RIM&C will no longer calibrate instrumentation for non-government clients or private citizens (unless those private citizens can demonstrate an official association with one of the aforementioned entities).

Any calibration orders that are currently in process will be completed, but no new calibration orders will be accepted from non-government clients or private citizens. We regret any inconvenience this may cause you or your organization, but please be advised that similar services are offered by private vendors. You may wish to contact a private vendor for your future calibration needs.
